## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the purpose of the J-Ticket?**

*The J-Ticket program is designed to maintain and grow Jewish Akron Family engagement*

### **How does the J-Ticket work?**

*A Jewish family pays the annual fee for the desired J-Ticket, then the agencies involved are paid an amount per J-Ticket by the JCBA from the Schultz Foundation funds.*

### **What is the time period for the J-Ticket?**

*The Lippman and ECE J-Ticket benefits are for the school year and therefore, begin in August 2017. Enrollment during the year will be prorated.*

### **How are payments made?**

*Payments may be made in full to the Jewish Community Board of Akron (JCBA), or payments can be arranged through the Lippman School or the Mandel ECE respectively depending on the ticket purchased.*

### **Is the J-Ticket available regardless of financial need?**

*The J-Ticket is available to all Jewish families, regardless of financial need.*

### **Can I purchase more than one J-Ticket?**

*Families with one child in The Lippman School and one child in the Mandel ECE may purchase one J-Ticket in each program for a total of two J-Tickets. No family may have two J-Tickets in the same program.*

*Additional children are at full tuition but may apply for financial aid. If enrolled in the Jewish Studies Program at Lippman School, you may also apply for the JCBA Scholarship.*
